Infant Baptism Preparation If you wish to arrange a baptism at Sacred Heart Church, please contact the Parish Center at 516-379-1356 ext.10. One of our baptism coordinators will be happy to arrange a time to meet with you. Ideally, both Godparents should be practicing Catholics. We will review the procedures for the sacrament and you will be able to fill out all the necessary paperwork. Baptisms are held on the first and third Sunday of each month at 2pm in the church. First time parents need to attend a baptism class. They are held on the last Monday of each month in the church at 7:30pm. Crying babies welcome! Godparents are encouraged but not required to attend.

A priest or deacon of the parish will interview you, set the wedding date and help you register for the required marriage preparation program. 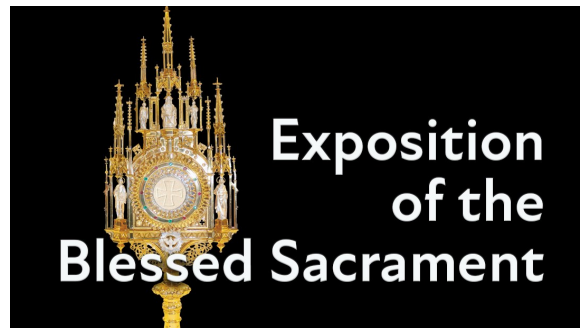

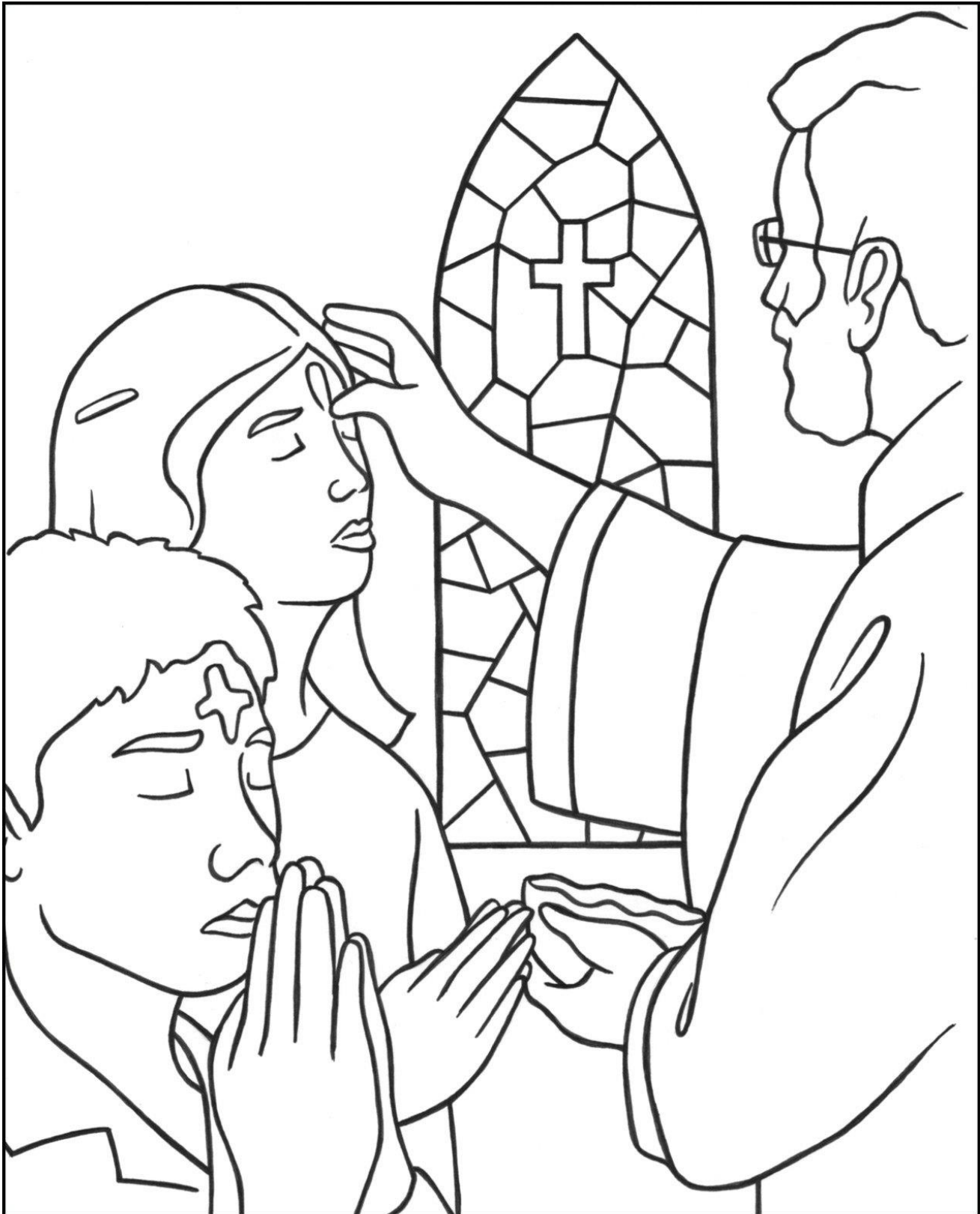

This is the Financial Report for Sacred Heart for the fiscal year ending August 31, 2022. We are pleased to end year with a surplus of \$112,876, primarily due to donations and gifts, collections and Parish Program revenues that were higher than anticipated. This surplus was partially offset by repairs to the church sound system and the wall behind the altar, as well as some repairs and renovations in the former convent.

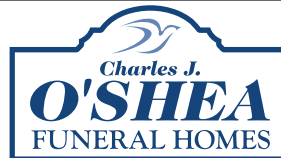
