A priest or deacon of the parish will interview you, set the wedding date and help you register for the required marriage preparation program. ***Sacrament of Reconciliation*** A priest is available each Saturday at 4:00PM in the church. Please don't hesitate to call a priest at the Parish Center for an appointment for Confession at another time.



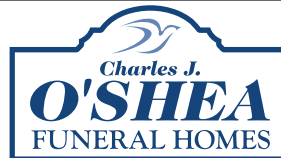
