Baptisms are held on the first and third Sunday of each month at 2pm. First time parents need to attend a baptism class. They are held on the last Monday of each month in the Parish Center at 7:30pm. Crying babies welcome! Godparents are encouraged but not required to attend.

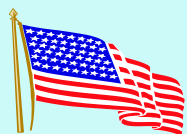

This is the Financial Report for Sacred Heart for the fiscal year ending August 31, 2024. We have ended the fiscal year with a surplus of \$540,273, primarily due to the sale of the house on Old Mill Road, less necessary renovations to the convent/new rectory.

As reported previously, we were able to take the proceeds from the sale to pay down a large portion of the mortgage on the church. The current balance of the mortgage mortgage as of October 31, 2024 is \$459,191.46


