Be Signs of Hope to
the World

Catholics can obtain a plenary indulgence, or Jubilee, during the 2025 Jubilee Year by:

- **Making a pilgrimage:** Visit a Jubilee site, such as a Major Papal Basilica in Rome, the Holy Land, or other designated ecclesiastical sites, or local church Holy Doors. (St. Agnes Cathedral, St. Patrick's Cathedral, Mother Cabrini Shrine)
- **Performing works of mercy:** Help the sick, disabled, or elderly, or visit prisoners.
- **Fasting:** Abstain from unnecessary consumption, such as smoking or alcohol, for at least one day.
- **Volunteering:** Devote time to community service.
- **Praying:** Pray for the intentions of the Pope and engage in Eucharistic adoration and meditation. Parish Exposition: Every Wednesday from 12pm-4pm
- **Confessing:** Sacramentally confess sins within 15 days before or after the visit. Parish Confession: Saturday: 4:00pm-4:45pm

Receiving communion: Receive the Sacrament of Eucharist. Weekday Mass: 9am
 Weekends: Saturday, 5pm, Sunday, 8am, 10am, 12pm & 5pm

A plenary indulgence is a grace that removes the temporal punishment for sins that have already been forgiven. It cleanses the soul as if the person had just been baptized. Indulgences obtained during the Jubilee Year can also be applied to souls in purgatory.


