Joe Lynch of Sacred Heart CYO Track was recently honored with the Role Model Award at the annual Diocesan CYO Dinner. Joe is a coach of the boys' track team.

Joe Lynch was born in Ireland, where he grew up playing Gaelic football and soccer. He emigrated to the United States in 2003 and met his wife Mary in New York. They settled in Merrick, where they are raising their two sons, Dylan and James. Joe is a carpenter by profession and took up running in 2012 in memory of his sister to raise money for Cystic Fibrosis. Since then, he has run over 20 marathons, including Chicago, Dublin, Berlin, Boston, NYC and many others. In 2023 he ran over 60 miles in a day doing a relay from Los Angeles to Las Vegas on a 360 mile course. Last year Joe received an award of Merit by the NY Irish Society for his running and charity work in the Irish American community.

He was also a grand marshal in the 2024 NYC St. Patrick's Day parade. Joe has been coaching at Sacred Heart since 2022 and looks forward to every spring.
