**Sacrament of Matrimony**

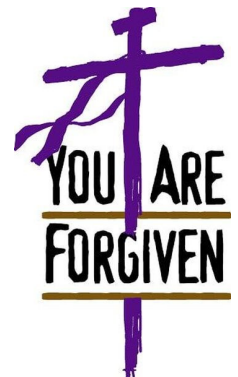

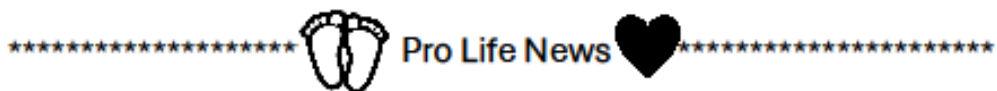


