Ideally, both Godparents should be practicing Catholics. We will review the procedures for the sacrament and you will be able to fill out all the necessary paperwork. Baptisms are held on the first and third Sunday of each month at 2pm. First time parents need to attend a baptism class. They are held on the last Monday of each month in the Parish Center at 7:30pm. Crying babies welcome! Godparents are encouraged but not required to attend.

A priest or deacon of the parish will interview you, set the wedding date and help you register for the required marriage preparation program. GIRLS REGISTRATION

This is the FINAL notice for SH Girls CYO Basketball registration for the 2025-2026 Girls Basketball season. Registration for Grades 4 – 12 will close on Friday, August 29.

BOYS REGISTRATION

This is the initial notice for the 2025-2026 Boys Basketball season. Registration for Grades 4-8 will start on August 18th and end on September 5th.

ALL registrations will be conducted on-line through the Sacred Heart Parish website. Registration fee is \$200 per child plus cost of uniform, if necessary. If you are a returning player and can use the previous seasons uniform then registration fee is \$200. If you are a returning player in need of a new uniform OR a new player needing a uniform there will be an additional \$60 registration fee. A \$10 discount will be provided for each additional child registered in the program.

Payment is by credit card only. The following guidelines apply to all registrants:
* All registrants should be either a member of SH Parish, reside within the SH Parish boundaries or reside within a neighboring parish not supporting a CYO Basketball program.

* Maximum number of players, per team, is targeted at 12 players. Teams may be based on the number of registrants, player's ability and available coaches for that grade

* Tryouts may be necessary based on the number of registrants and available coaches




