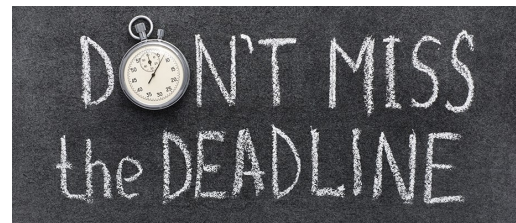

Giving Tree

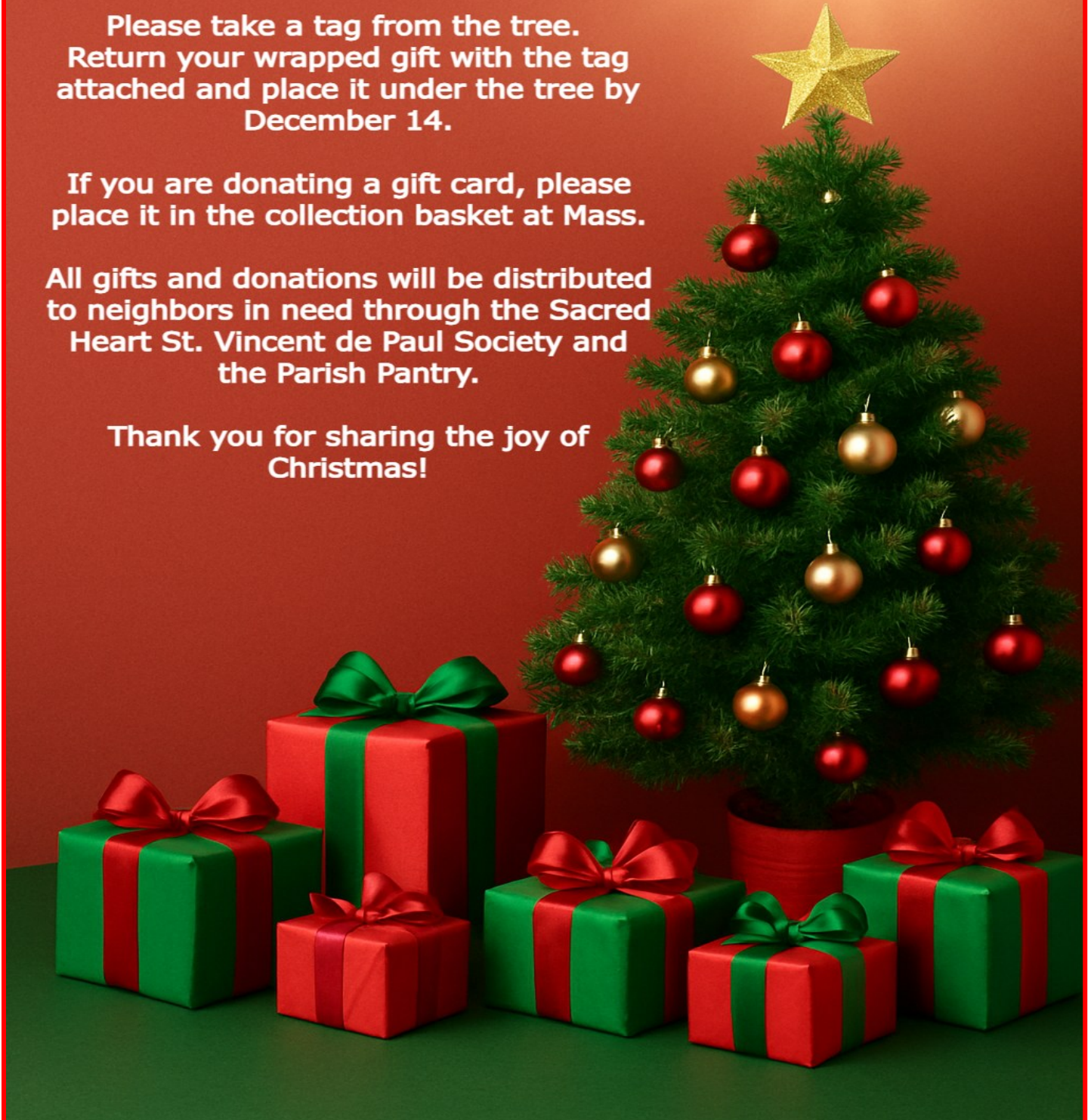
Our annual Giving Tree will be set up on Thanksgiving Weekend.

The Feast of the Immaculate Conception is Monday December 8th

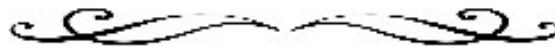

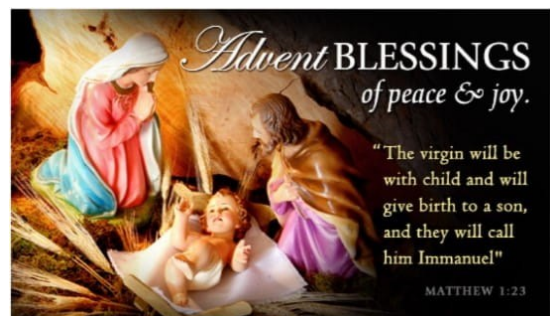
We have a nice selection of new and gently used coats in the Outreach office. Please come in if we can give you a coat.


