Chalking the Door An Epiphany tradition for your family.

On the Feast of the Epiphany, (January 4, 2026), the family gathers to ask God's blessing on their home and on those who live in or visit the home. Marking the doorway to one's home is rooted in the Old Testament. Holy Scripture reminds us that God has at times commanded his people to mark their doors. The Israelites marked their doors with the lamb's blood on the night of the passover (Exodus 12:7).

A traditional way of doing this is to use chalk to write above the home's entrance. It can also be written somewhere inside the home.

+20 C M B 26+

The letters C, M, B have two meanings:

They are the initials of the traditional names of the three magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar.

They also abbreviate the Latin words *Christus mansionem benedicat*, "May Christ bless the house."

The "+" signs represent the cross and 2026 is the year.

Make the sign of the cross in remembrance of your baptism then recite the following prayer: *May the Lord watch over our going out and our coming in, from this time forth and forevermore. Amen.*

"Chalking the door" is a way to celebrate and physically mark the occasion of the Epiphany and God's blessing of our lives and home. With time the chalk will fade. It is a reminder to let the meaning of the written symbols sink into the depths of our heart and be manifested in our words and actions.

Next weekend, January 3rd & 4th cards Epiphany cards will be available so you can 'chalk the door.'


