# 40 DAYS FOR LIFE

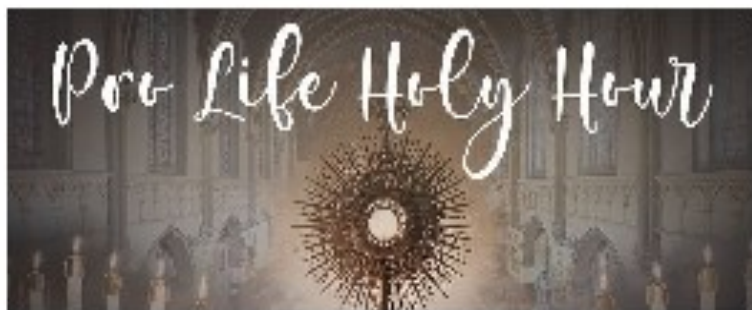
