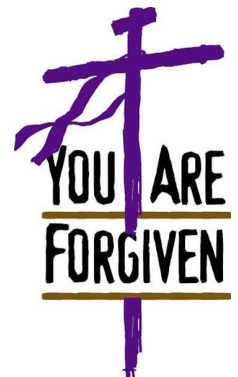
Sacrament of Reconciliation

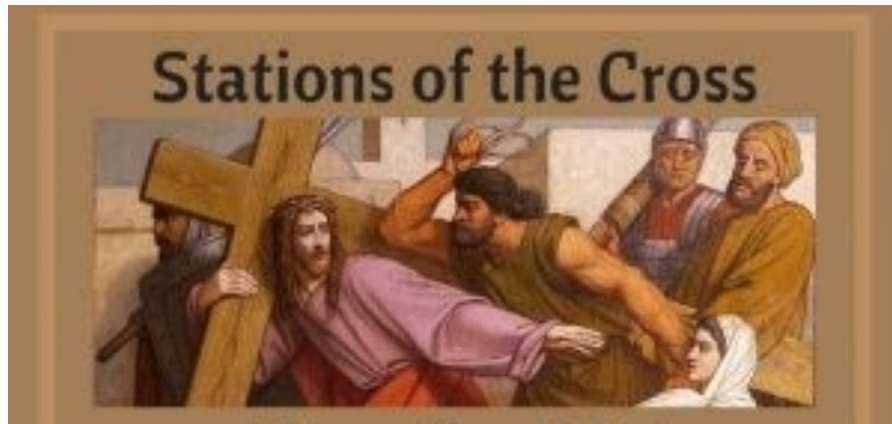

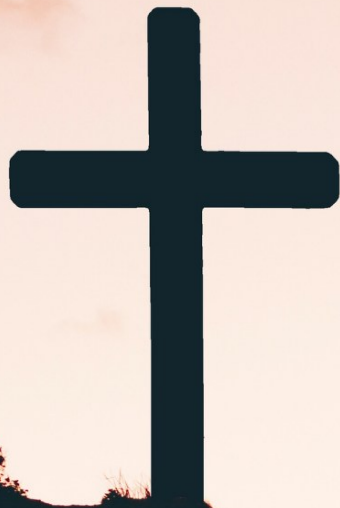


