Godparents are encouraged but not required to attend.

A priest or deacon of the parish will interview you, set the wedding date and help you register for the required marriage preparation program. 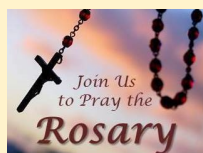

BAMBINELLI SUNDAY AT SACRED HEART

The 3rd Sunday of Advent, December 12, is called Gaudete Sunday. Gaudete means "rejoice". We rejoice because we are almost at Christmas, the day where we celebrate the birth of Jesus, the greatest gift we have ever been given.

St. John Paul II began a tradition where he invited the children of Rome to assemble in St. Peter's Square on the Third Sunday of Advent. He asked them to bring their little statue of the baby Jesus that would be placed in their Nativity set at home. John Paul II blessed the figurines of those present.

Both Pope Benedict XVI and Pope Francis have continued the tradition, and in recent years it has started to expand to other places outside of Rome.

We will once again celebrate our own "Bambinelli Sunday" at Sacred Heart on the Third Sunday of Advent.

You are invited to bring your figure of the Christ Child from your home crèche (Nativity scene) to any Mass on December 11th or 12th.



The Immaculate Conception A Holy Day of Obligation

Who does the Immaculate Conception refer to?

There's a popular idea that it refers to Jesus' conception by the Virgin Mary. It doesn't. Instead, it refers to the special way in which the Virgin Mary herself was conceived.

What is the Immaculate Conception? The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains it this way: to become the mother of the Savior, Mary "was enriched by God with gifts appropriate to such a role." The angel Gabriel at the moment of the annunciation salutes her as "full of grace". In fact, in order for Mary to be able to give the free assent of her faith to the announcement of her vocation, it was necessary that she be wholly borne by God's grace. As Pope Pius IX proclaimed in 1854: The most Blessed Virgin Mary was, from the first moment of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege of almighty God and by virtue of the merits of Jesus Christ, Savior of the human race, preserved immune from all stain of original sin.

How is Mary a parallel of Eve? Adam and Eve were both created immaculate--without original sin or its stain. They fell from grace, and through them mankind was bound to sin. Christ and Mary were also conceived immaculately. Through them mankind was redeemed from sin. Christ is thus the New Adam, and Mary the New Eve.
