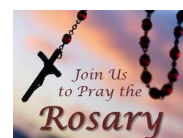

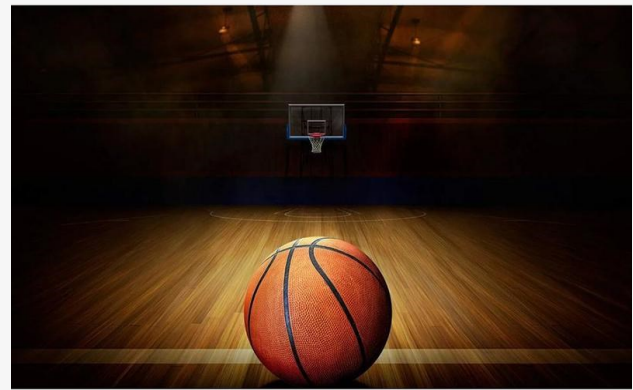
Dear Sacred Heart Parishioners:
