

Infant Baptism Preparation If you wish to arrange a baptism at Sacred Heart Church, please contact the Parish Center at 516-379-1356 ext.10. One of our baptism coordinators will be happy to arrange a time to meet with you. Ideally, both Godparents should be practicing Catholics. We will review the procedures for the sacrament and you will be able to fill out all the necessary paperwork. Baptisms are held on the first and third Sunday of each month at 2pm in the church. First time parents need to attend a baptism class. They are held on the last Monday of each month in the church at 7:30pm. Crying babies welcome! Godparents are encouraged but not required to attend.

Sacrament of Matrimony Please contact the Parish Center *at least one year in advance* of the intended date of the wedding. A priest or deacon of the parish will interview you, set the wedding date and help you register for the required marriage preparation program. In an effort to make sure parishioners who are ill are properly prayed for we would like to keep our Sick List as up to date as possible. On June 19, 2022, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) launched a Eucharistic Revival initiative. Over the next several years, the dioceses in the United States will recommit ourselves to our Eucharistic identity and will reaffirm our faith in the Real presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

The parish of Sacred Heart began **weekly Eucharistic Adoration on Wednesday, June 22nd from 12pm to 4pm** (12:30 if there is a funeral). There is a need for a committed adorer for each hour.

What better way to love God than to spend time with Him? The Vatican guidelines for Eucharistic Exposition require 2 or 3 persons to be present at all times. Thus, we strive to always have two committed adorers at every hour.

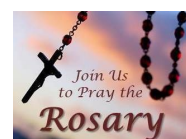
